NATIONAL PONY SOCIETY

NPS Summer Championship Qualifying Rounds

These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in any of the British Riding Pony studbook sections or the Ridden Register; the GSB; the AHSB; the AASB, or registered in the main body of their respective M&M Stud Book. Part bred are not eligible unless over stamped into one of the British Riding Pony studbook sections. or the Ridden Register. Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non members but only ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern 2024. The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

NPS Winter Championship Qualifying Rounds

This show is affiliated to the National Pony Society and the NPS affiliated classes will be run under NPS rules. Classes are open to Members and Non-Members of the NPS, but Non-Members will need to become members to enter the finals at the NPS Spring Festival 2024. In each class the three highest placed ponies, not already qualified, within the first six places, will qualify. Qualification cards will be awarded in the ring.

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships

These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a Qualifying or Life member of the NPS. The owner's valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.

SHETLAND PONY STUD BOOK SOCIETY

1. Classes must be confined to SPS-BS registered ponies or foals eligible for registration. Ponies must be named on the entry form and in the catalogue if one is produced.
2. Three-year-old fillies with foals at foot may not be shown. All foals must be a minimum of three weeks old on the day of the Show.
3. IN ORDER TO ENTER A STALLION CLASS AT AN AFFILIATED SHOW, ENTIRE MALES AGED 4 YEARS OLD AND OVER MUST HAVE AN "S" NUMBER AND HAVE BEEN SUCCESSFULLY THROUGH EITHER THE SPS-BS STALLION ASSESSMENT PRIOR TO 2006 OR THE CURRENT SPS-BS VOLUNTARY VETERINARY EXAMINATION. Ridden stallions MUST display a stallion bridle badge. In-hand entire males 2 years and over are advised to display a stallion bridle badge.
4. There must be no colts or entire males in Young Handlers classes. Children under 14 years old may not show colts (excluding foals) or entire males in In-hand classes. Children under 12 years old on the day of the show may not show entire males in ridden classes. In the interests of safety, hard hats must be worn by all handlers aged 14 years or under in In-hand classes. Exhibitors should not kneel but remain standing while in the ring. Hard hats must be worn by all exhibitors, irrespective of age, in ridden classes. Ridden and driven ponies must be 4 years old or over. In ridden Classes, if a rider falls off at any time whilst in the ring, both pony and rider must leave the ring, rider dismounted, and take no further part.



TRADITIONAL GYPSY COB ASSOCIATION

TGCA Breed classes are qualifiers for the Best of Breed Finals at the Traditional Gypsy Cob Association's (TGCA) National Breed Championship Show "TOYS". Traditional Classes are open to all traditional gypsy cobs and are qualifiers for the Traditional Finals at 'TOYS'. Part Bred classes, are open to all part bred traditional gypsy cobs and are qualifiers for the part bred finals at "TOYS". The exhibit must have one parent that is a traditional gypsy cob. Current TGCA members must present their Membership card and Qualification card to the judge in the ring for signature.

Non-members MUST receive a qualification card from the judge and have 21 days to join the TGCA and register their horse to validate the qualification. Please refer to www.tgca.co.uk for further details including membership, horse registration and showing rules (contained within the members handbook).

Quest for a Star Championship Inc Youngstock Quest for a Star- Traditional Gypsy Cobs

1st, 2nd and 3rd from the TGCA classes above may go forward to the Quest for a Star Championship as per below rule. ONLY current TGCA members and horse/pony that is already TGCA registered can exhibit in this championship, if exhibit already has their Quest for a Star Qualification in particular section, they should be ask stand aside to allow members that have not yet qualified. Membership card and Member's qualification card (specific to that exhibit) must be presented upon entry into the ring. The Champion and Reserve qualify for the Ultimate Star Championships at TOYS.

Go for Glory Championship - Part Bred Traditional Gypsy Cobs

1st, 2nd and 3rd from the TGCA part bred classes may go forward to the Go for Glory Championship. For TOYS qualifiers, the handler/rider and exhibits (apart from stallions) do not have to be TGCA members/registered on the date of the show. The Champion and Reserve qualify for the Crowning Glory Championships at TOYS.

The Greatest Gelding Award - Traditional Gypsy Cobs

The award is aimed to encourage the showing of geldings, therefore creating a market for often unwanted colt foals and enabling the creation of a network of potential performance prospects to represent the best Traditional Gypsy Cob breed in the World at the highest level. This Award should be given to the highest placed registered Traditional Gelding.

RULES AND REGULATION

It is a condition of entry that exhibitors agree to be bound by the rules hereunder.

1. All Foals must be WEANED and at least 20 WEEKS OLD on the day of the Show.
2. Foals must not be bitted and must only be shown in a halter or leather head collar.
3. Clipping/Trimming of all animals will be as per Breed Standard. If the Section of Classes is affiliated to a society, then there rules will take precedence.
4. All Colts Two Years Old and Over must hold a current Stallion Licence, unless otherwise governed by their individual Breed Society.
5. Handlers of Colts must have attended their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year. All handlers aged 14 years and under must wear a correctly secured current British Standard Riding Hat/Skull Cap.
6. No Clipping of Foals. Light trimming of the jaw line is permitted provided it does not exceed to the head or down the foals' neck. Ears may be trimmed but not clipped out.
7. All exhibits must be registered, or eligible to be registered, in the main body of their respective breed/type society stud book.
8. Foals and Youngstock must be shown suitable to their breed/type.
9. The Midlands Foal and Youngstock Show, Onley Grounds Equestrian Complex or any of its officers, servants or assistants shall not be held responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage that may happen from/to any animal, property or vehicle brought onto the showground, or whilst entering or leaving the same or otherwise or anything else in connection with or arising out of or attributable to the show or to the conditions or rules prescribed by the committee or by the rules of South Staffordshire College thereto.
10. Each Exhibitor shall be solely responsible for any consequential loss, injury or damage to/or occasioned by or arising from any animal or vehicle, including the spread of contagious disease exhibited or introduced to the Showground by him / her and shall indemnify the Show and It's Officials, against all actions damages costs and expenses in relation to and arising out of his/her entry or entries in the Show and will signify acceptance of this, by signing the Official Entry Form.
11. It is the owner's due diligence to ensure that horses/ponies are properly secure whilst onboard their horsebox/trailer. No horses show be left tied to the side of the horsebox/trailer.
12. Only horses and ponies that have been entered into the show will be allowed onsite.
13. Horseboxes/trailers must not be mucked out onto the showground.
14. All Litter and rubbish must be taken home or placed in the bins provided around the Showground.
15. Children must be supervised at all times by a competent adult whilst on the Showground. Parents/guardians are fully responsible at all times for the Health and Safety of children in their care when on the showground.
16. All Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times whilst on the showground. Is it the Owners responsibility to clean up after their dogs and place in the bins provided.
17. Smoking is not permitted within any enclosed area on the college site. Designated Smoking Areas are clearly signposted.
18. The Judges decision will be final.
19. The Midlands Foal and Youngstock Show asks that any Amateur Exhibitors enter the competition in the spirit it is intended. Any exhibitors who contravene the Amateur Ruling will be disqualified and may be barred from entering the show in future years.
20. In the interest of safety, please obey the instructions of the show committee or any other official of the show at all times.
21. Entries shall be accepted on the assumption that all owners/exhibitors have fully read the schedule and the rules.
22. Entries will not be refunded unless a Veterinary/Doctors certificate is produced. Refunds will be made within 30 days of the show.
23. Any objections to entries or awards must be made in writing to the secretary, on the show day accompanied by a deposit of £50. If the Show Committee feel the objection is not sustained the deposit will be forfeited. All objections must be made within an hour of the occurrence/incident.

Amateur/Home Produced

Open to Horses, which are either stabled at home or in a D. I. Y. yard and which since 1st January in the current year, have not been shown by a Professional during the current season or stabled in a Professional yard at any time in the current year. To be ridden by an Amateur. This does not exclude Amateur Owner Home Produced riders having lessons at any time with an instructor, providing the Horse remains stabled at home. No Professional, including Professional Grooms, are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the Horse.
